- 1. Improve the accuracy of patient identification.
- Improve the effectiveness of communication among caregivers and care recipients.
- Improve the safety of using medications and medical devices.
- 4. Reducing the risk of healthcare associated infections.
- Ensuring correct site, correct procedure, correct patient for all procedures.
- Accurately and completely reconcile medications across the continuum of care.
- Encourage patients' active involvement in their own care as a patient safety strategy.
 - Improve recognition and response to changes in a patient's condition.
- 9. Reducing risk of patient harm resulting from falls.
- 10. Reduce the risk of hospital fires.
